Payments & Financial Obligations

PLAN A - FULL payment due by May 1, 2018 (5% discount; 2% with credit card)

PLAN B - TWO payments due by May 1, 2018 & December 1, 2018 (3% discount; 1% with credit card)

PLAN C - TWELVE payments due May 1, 2018 - April 1, 2019 and made via preauthorized debit

Late Fee

A late fee of \$250 will be applied at the time of a current student's re-enrolment if such re-enrolment takes place after May 1st, 2018. Late fees are non-refundable.

School Supply Fees

School Supply Fees are collected by the school on behalf of the Parent Action Committee and are payable as per the tuition payment selected in the 2018-2019 Re-Enrolment or Enrolment Agreement (annually, in two payments, or on the 12 monthly payment plan by preauthorized debit. School Supply Fees are non refundable.

Trip Fees

Trip Fees are payable as per the tuition payment method selected in the 2018-2019 Re-Enrolment or Enrolment Agreement (annually, in two payments, or on the 12 monthly payment plan by preauthorized debit. Trip Fees are non-refundable.

Sibling Discount

A sibling discount is available for students in Kindergarten to Grade 12 who share at least one parent in common (i.e. cousins are not eligible for the sibling discount). The oldest sibling will owe the 1st Student Tuition Rate at that student's grade level, the second oldest sibling will receive a 25% discount and owe the 2nd Student Tuition Rate at that student's grade level, and the third and subsequent siblings will receive a 50% discount and owe the 3rd+ Student Tuition Rate at that student's grade level. Play School students are not eligible for sibling discounts or considered to be siblings in calculations of sibling discounts.

International & Non-Resident Students

The school does not receive provincial government funding for international students or students whose legal guardians are non-residents. Because of this, international and non-resident tuition fees reflect the cost of providing a full educational program to these non-funded students. International and Non-Resident students must also pay the School Supply Fees and Trip Fees applicable to that student's grade level.

Play School Fees

No discounts or fee reductions will be applied to Play School tuition fees for absences or sick days. To request a change in the days or number of days a Play School student is enrolled, the Admissions Manager must receive a change request in writing one month before the change is requested to occur. The Admissions Manager may decline any enrolment change at his/her discretion and subject to space availability.

NSF Charges

A charge of \$40 will be applied for pre-authorized debits that are returned to the School by your financial institution because of insufficient funds. The family must make immediate arrangement for replacement of refused payments. If acceptable arrangements are not made, the account will be considered in arrears and the student may be asked to withdraw.

Loss of Student Funding

A portion of the School's costs of providing education to each student are paid for by the provincial government in the form of per student funding. Except in extenuating circumstances, in the event that a student's poor attendance results in the School not receiving all or a portion of this provincial government funding for that student, the student's parents will be responsible for paying to the School the amount of the provincial government funding lost.

Tuition Adjustment

We are committed to ensuring that no family for whom the school is a good fit will be turned away due to financial hardship. If it is truly a hardship for a family to pay the full fees, a Tuition Adjustment Program may be available where an adjustment is made to the tuition owed by the family. School Supply Fees and Trip Fees are not adjusted. Tuition adjustment is available through a confidential application process. Please contact the Admissions Manager for more information.

Additional Fees

There may be additional fees required from time to time, such as fees for musical instruments, additional school field trips, special projects, etc.
