International Student Program Initial Study Permit Application Information

All international students in Grades 1-12 studying at Whistler Waldorf School require a valid study permit.

A study permit gives you permission to study and stay in Canada on a temporary basis.

- You need your study permit application approved before you come to Canada, and you must apply for your initial study permit outside Canada.
- Start the application process **as soon as** you receive your offer of admission from Whistler Waldorf School to ensure you get your permit in time.
- If your study permit application is approved, you will be issued a **Letter of Introduction** (sometimes referred to as a Letter of Approval or an Approval Letter).
- You must present this letter to the border officer when you arrive at the Canadian border.
- The officer will then issue your study permit at the border.

When to apply	Apply as soon as you get accepted to Whistler Waldorf School and have been issued a Letter of Acceptance & Declaration of Custodianship (if staying in a homestay)
How long it will take	IRCC processing times vary widely. Check typical processing times for your country on the IRCC website. It can take several months to get approved for a study permit so it's important to apply as soon as possible.
